## Safety Tips for Children

- Never share your name, school, address or phone number online.

## Safety Tips for Students

- Use strong passwords and never share OTPs.
- Avoid free WiFi for login to important accounts.
- Do not upload personal photos publicly.
- Beware of scholarship scams and fake job offers.
- Keep social media accounts private.

## Guidelines for Parents

- Keep devices in common family areas.
- Use parental control apps and screen time limits.
- Talk regularly about online dangers.
- Check friend lists and privacy settings.
- Teach children how to report suspicious users.

## Safety Tips for Adults

- Verify online shopping websites before payment.
- Do not share bank details or OTP on calls.
- Enable two factor authentication on accounts.
- Update phone and apps regularly.
- Use antivirus and avoid pirated software.
