

How to Report Internet Scam

This guide helps you identify and report phishing emails, fake websites, lottery scams, romance scams, and other internet frauds. Early reporting protects both you and other users.

Common Internet Scams

- 1 Phishing Emails – fake bank or service emails asking for OTP/password
- 2 Fake Websites – duplicate shopping or payment pages
- 3 Lottery Scams – messages claiming prize money
- 4 Tech Support Fraud – callers pretending to fix your computer
- 5 Romance Scams – emotional manipulation for money

How to Identify a Scam

- 1 Urgent payment requests
- 2 Unknown links asking login details
- 3 Poor grammar or unusual email address
- 4 Request for OTP or PIN
- 5 Too-good-to-be-true offers

How to Report

- 1 Call 1930 immediately for financial fraud
- 2 Report at cybercrime.gov.in portal
- 3 Inform your bank and block transaction
- 4 Save screenshots and evidence

Safety Tips

- 1 Never share OTP, PIN, or passwords
- 2 Verify website URL before payment
- 3 Do not trust unknown callers
- 4 Avoid installing remote access apps
